We wish you a happy, blessed Easter season!

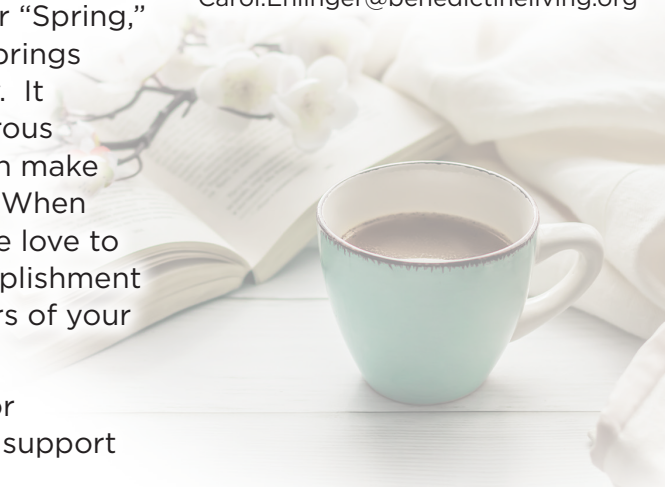

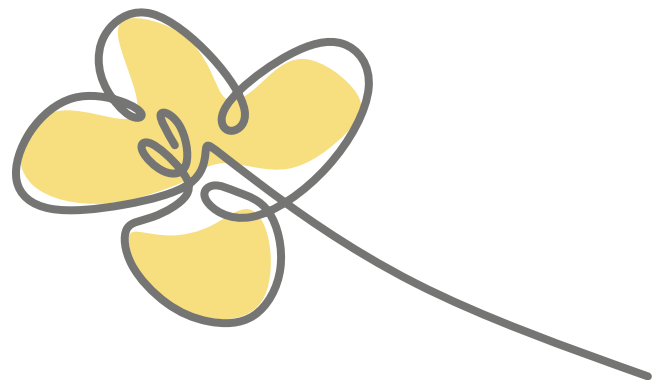

At Benedictine Living Community – Saint Anne, we are incredibly grateful for the generosity of our Foundation donors. Your support continues to make a meaningful difference in the lives of our residents, families, and associates every day.

One of the most visible impacts of Foundation funding can be seen on our Transitional Care Unit (TCU), where new recliners have been purchased for resident use. These recliners provide enhanced comfort, support, and safety for individuals recovering from surgery or illness. Having access to high-quality seating allows residents to rest more comfortably, participate in therapy, and regain strength in a setting that feels both supportive and home-like.

Foundation dollars have also played a critical role in improving safety and quality of care through the installation of ceiling lifts. Most recently, three ceiling lifts have been added to our newly renovated spa rooms, with an additional seven being installed in resident rooms throughout the building. These lifts allow for safer transfers, reduce the risk of injury, and support our caregivers in providing the best possible care.

In our Therapy department, past Foundation support has made it possible to purchase specialized bariatric equipment, including a NuStep and an electric standing frame. These tools allow our team to better serve residents with varying needs, particularly those on TCU, by promoting mobility, strength, and independence during their recovery journey.

Beyond the walls of our community, Foundation contributions have enhanced our outdoor spaces as well. Landscaping improvements to the Saint Anne's front patio have created a more welcoming and peaceful environment for residents and families to enjoy.

Each of these improvements reflects more than just an upgrade in equipment or environment—they represent an investment in comfort, safety, and healing. Because of your generosity, we are able to continue enhancing the experience of those we serve and creating a community that truly feels like home.
